Springfield Dance Summer Schedule

June 1st – July 26th

Register now for Summer Classes

Summer classes will begin June 1st and will run through July 26th for regular classes. We will also be holding dance camps during June, July and August. Each camp will be held Monday through Thursday culminating in a Showcase Performance the last 10 minutes of each camp session.

Again we will offer the **Mini Prince/Princess Fairytale Dance and Your Majesty's Royal Ballet!** These classes will give the children an idea what it is like to be a *REAL* Prince or Princess! We will creatively explore different royal ballets along with lessons in etiquette, drama and music and will be offered for children 18-36 months and 3-6 years old. For camp enthusiasts, we will have **Circus! Circus! and Wicked Mini Theatre Camps!** These camps will focus on learning song and dance routines, make up and dramatic scenes culminating in a performance in one four hour session! Our **Adaptive Program** for children with special needs is a parent/child class helping the children gain motor skill strength through creative movement. We will base the class on ballet and jazz curriculums, but the focus will remain flexible based on the student's needs. **Dance Practical** is for students 11 and up and the focus will be something different every week. We will cover topics like hair, make-up, sewing pointe shoes, improvisation, dance history, assisting and more!

All new pre-pointe and pointe students are required to be fitted for proper shoes after enrolling in classes. Please make sure you get your child sized in the office by May 1st. (proof of enrollment is necessary to order the shoes).

Add Drop classes

Any student making changes to their class schedule **must** fill out an add/drop slip in order for the office to make appropriate changes. *Refunds will not be issued, however the balance may be transferred to another class.*

Tuition

Adding the number of class hours per week and applying it to the fee chart determines tuition. Multiple family members: add the number of hours per student and take a \$20 discount off the total for each additional student (after the first student). Dance Camp students who are enrolled in a regular dance class will receive a \$40 discount. The first payment (1/2 tuition) is due upon registration and the balance is due June 1st. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS FOR MISSED CLASSES ONCE TUITION HAS BEEN PAID.** Make checks payable to Springfield Dance.

Studio Rules

- ❖ No chewing gum
- ❖ No food or drink in dressing rooms or studios
- ❖ No excessive talking. A very disruptive child will be asked to sit and watch.
- ❖ No street shoes will be allowed in the dance studios. If parents need to walk into the studio, shoes must be removed, or paper shoe covers are available at the front desk.

Attire

- ❖ Ladies – solid colored leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, and footless tights for modern dance – jazz shoes are optional. Hair must be worn in a bun (if length permits) or tied back securely out of the face to avoid injury.

- ❖ Gentlemen – T-shirt and loose comfortable pants or shorts, black ballet shoes, barefoot for modern – jazz shoes are optional.
- ❖ Adults – Loose comfortable clothing, pink ballet shoes (for ballet class), – jazz shoes are optional.
- ❖ Gymnastics – tight clothing and secure hair.
- ❖ All items may be ordered through the studio office.

Observation

All parents are asked to wait in the lobby area while class is in progress, with the exception of the Showcase Performances held during the last class of the session.
